DISCUSSION: [Revelation 1:1-20](#)

Feel free to break off into smaller groups if it helps you share more personally

1. *When you hear Revelation 1 read out loud, what strikes you? What things sound familiar and what parts pique your interest or raise questions?*
2. *To a persecuted church, imagine how this letter, and even just this prologue, would have been received. Which parts in particular speak hope to a suffering church?*
3. *Putting aside the cliches and pat answers that are normally associated with such a question, what are your hopes for the future? What are the things pushing against that hope?*
4. *How does this recounting of this vision of Jesus (vv. 9-20) encourage or challenge your hope?*
5. *Pray for the Church, that we may hold fast to "the Alpha and the Omega...who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty," our only hope.*
