Sermon Discussion Questions | [1 Samuel 26:6-25](#)

- 1) What do you know about Saul and his reign? Why did God say that the people had rejected him in asking for a king like the other nations?
- 2) What stands out to you about the reasons David gives for his refusal to kill Saul?
- 3) David recognizes Saul as the Lord's anointed - his enemy, but one that God has chosen. Have you ever felt like God himself was opposed to you? What do you do with this?
- 4) How do we understand David's assertion that God has dealt with him according to his righteousness? How is this statement (applied to ourselves) both the bad news and the good news of the gospel?
- 5) What is it significant about v. 24? Notice that David does not appeal to SAUL to value his life. What does this show us about where David's security lies?

Pray for yourselves and the church that we would deepen our reliance on God in the midst of trials, and be able to bear one another's burdens.
