## Sermon Discussion Questions | 1 Kings 2:1-4, 10-12; Psalm 1

- 1. Where have you found the "divinely revealed emotional language" contained in the Psalms to be of most benefit to you in recent months?
- 2. What does Psalm 1 mean when it refers to "meditation" on the law of the Lord?
- 3. Can you give examples of how sin often involves a slow, gradual, passive slide from "walking" to "standing" to "sitting" ("endure, then pity, then embrace," as Pope put it)?
- 4. What do we learn about happiness from the image of a "tree, planted by streams of water, which yields fruit in its season"? What do the images of *rootedness*, access to streams of water, and seasons tell us?
- 5. How does this counter our cultural instincts toward rootlessness?
- 6. How has Jesus resolved the tension of vv. 5-6?
- 7. Pray that you and the church would grow in delight in God's law, that we would both be blessed and a blessing (Gen. 12:3).
