Sermon Discussion Questions | Psalm 51

- 1. Look at 2 Samuel 11. What are some features *in the text* that suggest that David is ironically *growing more passive* and *abusing his power* at the same time?
- 2. Can you define repentance?
- 3. In Psalm 51:1, what is the basis that David gives for repentance? How does this differ from the basis we usually bring to confession?
- 4. Why is honesty about our sin (Ps. 51:3-6) a crucial but *very* challenging hurdle to repentance?
- 5. How do you understand David's statement that his sin is against God "only"?
- 6. What does this story and Psalm teach us about the corporate nature of both sin and repentance/reconciliation?
- 7. Pray for the church, that we would be a people marked by repentance and rest, quietness and trust (Isa. 30:15).
