- 1. Read Luke 2:8-21
- 2. Discuss how we discover joy in the Glory of God. What did the Angels see? Why do Angels long to look into these things? 1 Peter 1:10-13
- 3. Why is the peace in vs 14 not political or personal but God's commitment to end the war between us and him? How do we experience the remnants of the war in our growth with him? See Romans 8:1-11.
- 4. How does knowing he is pleased with us lead to worship?
- 5. What increases our capacity for Joy at Christmas? Read John 16:16-24.
