## Sermon Discussion Questions | Leviticus 18:1-5; 20:22-26

- 1. What is your experience of the word "holy"? Does it have primarily positive or negative connotations?
- 2. What does holy actually mean in the bible? What does it mean when God says, "You shall be holy, for I am holy" (20:26)?
- 3. When Leviticus tells us that a person that keeps God's rules "will live by them," (18:5) what is it saying, and what is it not saying? In other words, go back to Paul's arguments from Romans can the law save us? So then, does that mean we should just ignore it?
- 4. Read Luke 8:43-48. What is shocking about this story in the context of Leviticus? How is this a picture of justification by faith?
- 5. Pray for the holiness of the church that we would be a people set apart, for the glory of God and the blessing of the city.
