Sermon Discussion Questions | Genesis 22:1-14

- 1. What lies are you tempted to believe God, and in what life circumstances? (That he is a cosmic tyrant, that he doesn't actually love us, that he is withholding, that he is not *for us*, etc.) How does the cross contradict these lies? (Romans 8:31-34)
- 2. How does faith as relational trust change the ways that we often view faith and how it grows / develops?
- 3. How does the story of Abraham and Isaac point to Jesus and the cross, the Father and his generous heart? How have we underestimated God's love and grace in our lives? And how does this depiction of God's sacrificial love inspire us to love God more?
