## Sermon Discussion Questions | Joel 2:1-17

- 1. Read Joel 2:1-17. What are the main ideas and themes?
- 2. How does God's discipline of His people reflect a loving Heavenly Father? Read Revelation 3: 14-22.
- 3. Discuss Jack Miller's "two cheer ups" in light of this passage. How would people in Joel's time experience these two thoughts?
  - #1 Cheer up! You are much worse than you know.
  - #2 Cheer up! You are much more loved than you could dream.
- 4. Why is it important for us to hold these two ideas together to daily experience the Gospel? Think about living in Romans 7&8 at the same time.
- 5. Look at vss. 12-14. What does it mean for us to return to the Lord with a whole heart? Why is it so hard for us to weep and mourn over our sin? What does it mean to rend our hearts?
- 6. Discuss the covenantal description of the character of God found in vs.13. What does it mean for God to relent?
- 7. Pray for God to bring revival to CTK through the prayer and repentance of its leadership first and then the community as a whole.
