## Week of 6/19/22

### DISCUSSION: John 6:16-21

1. Spend some time reflecting on the different areas of life in which fear is present. Why do you think fear is present in some areas of life and not others? What can we learn about ourselves, our community, and our culture by looking at what we fear? What is the relationship between fear and power? Fear and joy?
2. Read John 6:16-21. What were the disciples afraid of? How is Jesus's power on display? Why might someone be afraid to be in the presence of God?
3. Read Matthew 10:16-31. In this particular context of Jesus sending out the disciples, how does Jesus encourage the disciples to not fear? How might verse 28 bring comfort to those who are afraid?
4. Jesus calls us to not be afraid. How specifically can we pray as a group that we might trust Jesus for every fear we have?
