- Read Acts 2:14 – 41
- Think about being Peter and the Apostles being with the Resurrected Jesus for 40 days. Read Luke 24:44-49. What do you imagine their experience was like?
- What is the significance of Joel 2 being part of the first sermon?
- What impresses you about Peter's message?
- What does it mean for you to live in Jesus' story in fulfillment of the promises in this passage?
- From this passage, what would revival look like for CTK?
- Pray for revival, renewal and reformation in our life together at CTK.

Announcements:

UPDATE ON COVID-19 POLICIES FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP: As of May 29th, the state of Massachusetts and the city of Cambridge have lifted the mandatory guidelines required of places of worship. As we acclimate to this new stage of reopening, however, we will only be making gradual changes to our policies.

- There will be **two seating options**:
 - **Open**, for those who are comfortable sitting shoulder-to-shoulder with other households
 - **Distanced**, for those who would prefer to maintain six-feet distance from other households.
- Distanced seating will be assigned, and our greeters will direct you to your seats in the outer pew sections. Open seating will be unassigned, in the center pew section.
- Also, for the time being, we are **asking that everyone continue to wear masks indoors during the service** out of consideration for the comfort and well-being of others, including the many children in our congregation who are not vaccinated.
