Sermon Discussion Questions | Matthew 11:25-30

- 1. Read Matthew 11:25-30 and Hebrews 4:14-16
- 2. What do we need from Jesus which helps see our need?
- 3. What are the top three spiritual needs for CTK? How does God provide for us so He meets those needs. Pray for CTK renewal, reformation, revival.
- 4. Discuss the meaning of *gentle*? See Matthew 5:5
- 5. Discuss the meaning of *lowly*? See 2 Corinthians 8:9
- 6. Discuss this quote from Dane Ortlund: For all his resplendent glory and dazzling holiness, his supreme uniqueness and otherness, no one in human history has been more approachable than Jesus Christ.
- 7. Read this quote from J.I Packer on God's determination to bless us.

"What matters supremely, therefore, is not, in the last analysis, the fact that I know God, but the larger fact which underlies it - the fact that he knows me. I am graven on the palms of his hands. I am never out of his mind. All knowledge of him depends on his sustained initiative in knowing me. I know him because he first knew me, and continues to know me. He knows me as friend, one who loves me; and there is no moment when his eye is off me, or his attention distracted from me, and no moment therefore when his care falters. This is momentous knowledge. There is unspeakable comfort - the sort of comfort that energizes, be it said, not enervates - in knowing that God is constantly taking knowledge of me in love and watching over me for my good. There is tremendous relief in knowing that his love for me is utterly realistic, based at every point on prior knowledge of the worst about me, so that no discovery now can disillusion him about me, in the way I am so often disillusioned about myself, and quench his determination to bless me."
