Sermon Discussion Questions | Matthew 11:25-30; 1 John 1:5-2:2

- 1. Read 1 John 1:1-2:2
- 2. Notice three challenges about sin.
 - Vs 6. When we walk in darkness, what is distracting us? Are the cares and concerns of the world choking out the word, the light?
 - Vs. 8 Why is sin deceitful? Look at Mark 4:19 and Hebrews 3:13.
 - Vs. 10 Why is denial our default? Why is step one in the 12 steps so hard to take? How do we blame God for our problems?
- 3. How does the present value of the blood help us? Read vs. 7 and Hebrews 9:14.
- 4. Look at vs 9. How is God just to forgive us and cleanse us? How does Jesus our Advocate show up when we sin? Read 1 John 2:1-2. What does our Advocate tell us?
- 5. Read this stanza from *Let us love and sing and wonder:*

Let us wonder; grace and justice

Join, and point to mercy's store;

When through grace in Christ our trust is,

Justice smiles, and asks no more:

He who washed us with his blood,

Has secured our way to God.
