Sermon Discussion Questions | [Galatians 5:22-26](#)

1. Where else do you hear of fruitfulness in the Bible? What does the metaphor convey?
2. In what ways does Jesus emulate each of these fruit?
3. How is the cross central to Galatians? Reread 1.4; 2.20, 21; 3.1, 13; 6.14. What do you learn from these varied points? How is connection to the cross both passive and active?
4. Is it any surprise that relationships were frayed (vss. 15, 26) in Galatia? How do the works of the flesh and the fruit of the Spirit speak to this?
5. Pray for a reassessment of our relationships, maybe some repentance (and faith), to the end of our keeping in step with the Spirit.
