Sermon Discussion Questions | 1 Samuel 1:1-20

1. What do you know about David? Why do you think God called him “a man after my own heart”? (1 Sam. 13:14)
2. Can you understand or identify with Hannah’s sorrow in the first half of 1 Samuel 1?
3. What do you think about Elkanah’s response to Hannah (1:8)?
4. Why does Hannah have peace (vv. 9, 18) *before* God gives her a son?
5. What stands out to you about Hannah’s prayer (2:1-10)?
6. Spend some time praying for our church with *theological imagination*: connect the needs of our church to the bigger story of Jesus and His Church (Eph. 5:25-32).
